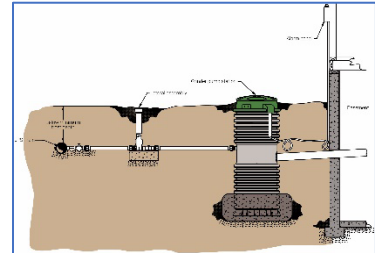

E-One Sewer Ejector Pump Replacement Program (SEP3)

The Merrillville Conservancy District (MCD) is taking measures to assist Freeholders (customers of MCD) with a financial contribution by providing funding for repairing or replacement of privately owned E-One sanitary sewer ejector pumps. This program has been implemented as part of the District's ongoing efforts to improve the quality of life of their customers. MCD understands the cost burden put on the property owner to repair or replace their sanitary sewer E-One ejector pumps. Therefore, MCD is willing to help the property owner financially by **reimbursing the freeholder (customer of MCD) up to 50% of the cost or a maximum of \$3,000, whichever is less**, for repairing or replacing their privately owned sanitary sewer E-One ejector pump. The property owner will be responsible for any cost over MCD's maximum contribution of \$3,000. This only applies to customers that are in good standing with MCD.



Program Details

- A reimbursement will be offered to freeholders that are in good standing and have no past due bills or liens.
- Items included for the reimbursement are for the repair of or the installation of a new sanitary sewer E-One ejector pump.
- All work must be completed by MCD or a Factory Authorized E-One Service Provider.
- Reimbursements are offered to residential properties that have the current Town of Merrillville residential zoning districts of R1 and R2.
- Reimbursements are available on a **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS** until funds are exhausted.
- If the funds are exhausted, the property owner is welcome to apply the following fiscal year, provided MCD is still offering the incentive.
- The property owner is responsible for any future maintenance and/or replacement costs.
- Freeholders are eligible for a one-time award per freeholder name and freeholder address.
- All applications must be submitted by the property owner.
- If the freeholder elects to take the no interest loan for their financial portion of the project the interest rate will be 0%.

Example of How the Loan Program Works

- If a freeholder chooses to take advantage of the no interest loan to cover their portion of an E-One pump project, here's what to expect:
 - **Payback Term**
 - Freeholders can choose how long to pay back the loan with a maximum term of 24 months.
 - **Payment Examples**
 - Assumed your project cost \$4,000 total.
 - MCD Grant Contribution (50% of the cost, up to \$3,000 maximum contribution): \$2,000

- Freeholder's Portion : \$2,000
- **Two Repayment Options for the Freeholder:**
 - **Option One**
 - The freeholder pays their share and MCD or a Factory Authorized E-One Service Provider performs the work and the project is closed out.
 - **Option Two**
 - The freeholder takes advantage of the no-interest loan for the Freeholder's share and MCD or a Factory Authorized E-One Service Provider performs the work
- **Loan Calculation Example**
 - The interest rate is set at: 0%
 - The freeholder's loan principal: \$2,000
 - Assume the freeholder opts for a two (2) year payback period
 - Repayment Term is two (2) Years
 - Monthly Billing
 - Extra loan payment per month will be ~\$83.33 / month for 24 monthly bills

TIME LINE – E-One Sewer Ejector Pump Repair and Replacement Program (SEP3)

Non-Emergency Repair

- Property owner request inspection of the E-One pump.
- District performs initial inspection of the E-One Pump (within 5 working days).
- District determines if the E-One pump will be repaired or replaced.
- Property owner submits completed application.
- District issues a Notice of Eligibility or Non-eligibility (within 3 working days).
- If the property owner receives a Notice of Eligibility, the property owner must pay the District up to 50% of the cost or a maximum of \$3,000, whichever is less or elect to take the no interest loan option.
- The District or a Factory Authorized E-One Service Provider will schedule the installation of the E-One pump.
- Owner must obtain all permits from the governing bodies.

If Owner fails to comply within any of the allotted time frames detailed above, funding priority ceases and Owner must submit new Application for Participation and such application will be treated as a new application for determination of funding eligibility.

**E-One Sewer Ejector Pump Replacement Program (SEP3)

Pursuant to the Merrillville Conservancy District (MCD) inflow removal program for qualifying Freeholders building sewers with simple clear water connections, I hereby request and consent for MCD and its authorized agents, contractors, staff, and representatives to come onto my property to inspect the property to identify defective laterals, sewer ejector pumps or illegal sump pump connections.
